GENERAL RULES

- 1. Violation of any rule will constitute a disqualification.
- 2. Tractors may be entered in no more than two classes per event, and only once per class.
 - *Unless otherwise stated in drivers meeting.
 - *Tractors may not be entered in Improved and Farm Stock at same event.
- Only Track personnel & operator of tractor hooked to sled allowed on track.
 - *ABSOLUTALY NO SPECTATORS
- All tractors must weigh in before pulling (50 lbs. Weight allowance)
- Front weights or bracket not to exceed 24" from front casting or 11ft from center of rear wheel to front of weight/bracket.
- 6. Tractors not ready when it's their turn to pull will be skipped and worked in later in the class.
- Any object that hits the pulling track from the tractor while hooked to the sled is cause for Disqualification -including weights while under green flag.
- 8. All Pulls to start with a tight chain. NO JERKING ALLOWED.
- 9. One attempt to stop before 75 feet; to restart for weight or gear change.
- 10. Disqualification if:
 - a) If weight or any object falls off tractor while under green flag.
 - b) Over speed limit at any point during the pull (including first 75ft.)
 - c) Tractor must remain in bounds and not touch boundary lines at any time.
- 11. Registration for each class will close when
 - a) The first tractor of prior class is to the sled.
 - b) Announcer calls the class closed.
 - d) 4500# closed once driver meeting begins.
- 12. Person who wins any payback must be the person collecting money.
- 13. Refunds for cancelation at promoters discretion.
- 14. All drawbars:
 - a) Will be measured on scale during weigh-in.
 - b) Minimum 18" from center of axel to hook point.
 - c) No more than 20" high.
 - d) Driver must supply clevis or 3 x 3.5 in hole in draw bar. (sled hook must pivot on hook point)
- 15. Written permission of parent/guardian if operator is under 18.
 - a) Parent/guardian and minor must sign release and waiver.
- If you disrupt a pull, or are caught tampering with other tractors you will be told to leave immediately.
- 17. Tractor owners and operators assume full responsibility for negligence and accidents.
- Driver must remain in seat during pull NO BOUNCING or JUMPING allowed.
- 19. No reckless driving of tractors will permitted on or off the track.
 - a) *HOT RODDING WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED!!!!
- 20. Track officials may disqualify any tractor and driver for:
 - a) Unsportsmanlike conduct
 - b) Intoxication
 - c) Failure to stop when red flagged.
- 21. Front wheels must maintain a safe distance from the ground; flag man discretion.
- 22. NO passengers at any time.
- 23. Puller ID RECOMMENDED to be visible on tractor, to ensure points are assigned properly.
- 24. Must have fan shroud.

FARM STOCK

- 1. After Green Flag-Tractors must maintain speed limits at all times (16500# exempt.)
 - a) 4mph; 4500#, 5500#, 6500#
 - b) 5mph: 7500#, 8500#, 9500#
 - c) 6mph; 10500#, 12500#, 14500#
- 2. No cut or altered tires
 - a) Must run forward on all track surfaces.
 - b) 18.4x38 or equivalent tire for the following classes: 4500#,5500#,6500#,7500#.
- 3. No Duals
- 4. Maximum 2850 RPM in all classes.
 - a) If protested:
 - a. RPM monitor will be placed/checked by Track Judge.
 - b. Prior to tractor departing track.
 - c. Failure to allow inspection will result in Disqualification (i.e.-open side shields)
- 5. Hitches must be rigid in all directions in all classes.
 - a) Fast hitch allowed pinned rigid.
 - b) Tractor with hitch adjuster that attaches at or above rear axle centerline MUST have wheelie bars.
- 6. Weights must be free of Hitch area.
- 7. Disqualification (DQ) result in no place points
- 8. No secondary or external injection systems allowed.
- 9. All tractors to have working brakes.
- 10. Must have working PTO.
- 11. JUDGES DECISION FINAL!

IMPROVED FARM TRACTORS

- 1. After Green Flag-Tractors must maintain speed limits at all times
 - a) 7mph; 5500#, 6500#
 - b) 10mph: 9000#, 11000#
- 2. Full cut tires allowed.
 - a) Can be run any direction
 - b) No size limit
- 3. No Duals
- 4. Maximum 2850 RPM in all classes.
 - a) If protested:
 - RPM monitor will be placed/checked by Track Judge.
 - b. Prior to tractor departing track.
 - Failure to allow inspection will result in Disqualification (i.e.-open side shields)
